Welcome back to school! How was your summer vacation? I hope you had an exciting and enjoyable summer vacation with your family and friends!

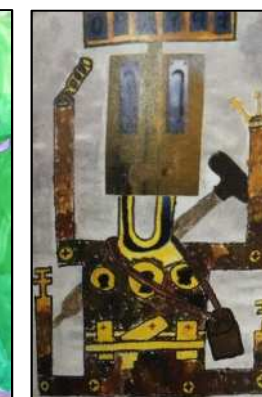
