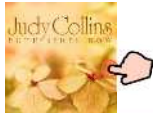
Hello everyone!

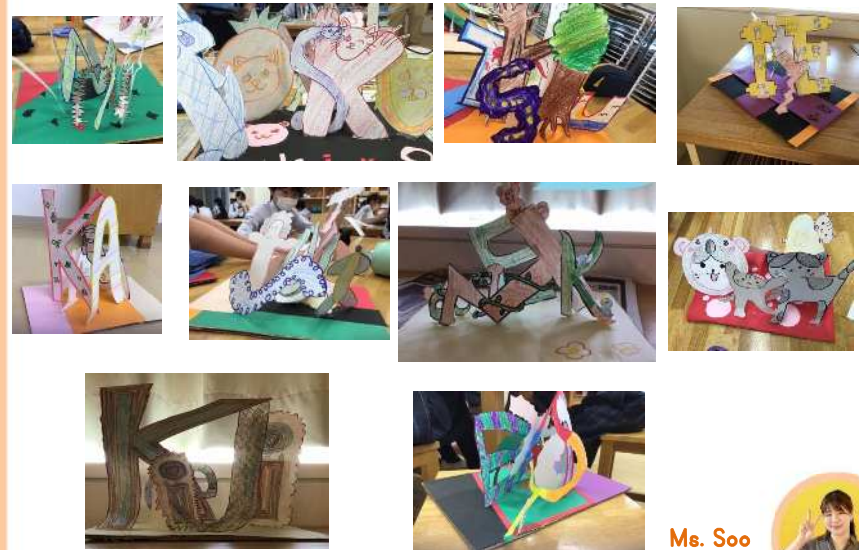

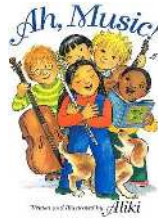
